LOVE YOUR LOCAL Meet Michael Cheng from Little Luscious

What inspired you to open Little Luscious?

We opened our first café, Luscious Café in Onehunga several years ago and had a lot of feedback from customers who lived around Ellerslie that we should open a café in the Village. The opportunity came up with a desirable location and we opened Little Luscious in 2016.

Tell us a bit about the food you serve?

95% of what we sell is made on-site. We make small batches and order our produce fresh every day which enables us to produce fresh food with very limited wastage. Our kitchen menu includes homemade items such as crunchy potato hash, hollandaise and aioli, plus all our savouries and sweets in our display cabinet are made on site.

What is the most rewarding part of running your cafe?

Being able to provide delicious food, coffee, and service to our customers and having them leave with a smile after having a great experience.

What do you love about the Ellerslie community?

Ellerslie community is amazing. People are very supportive and caring. If someone needs help, there will always be someone willing to lend a hand – there is a great community vibe here.

How are you celebrating Christmas?

Being a small family business, family comes first. We always find the time to get together to celebrate Christmas and it is special for us to have three generations together – kids to grandparents. After Christmas we like to get out of Auckland to wind-down and relax, as this is really our only opportunity to have a holiday during the year.




